Applications will be interviewed and will need to demonstrate:

- ◆ an interest in art (including an appreciation of different themes, media and approaches to art practice)
- ◆ basic drawing skills
- ◆ communication skills
- ◆ comprehension, literacy and numeracy skills

A folio of work, a journal and evidence of educational records, may help in providing evidence of the above.

Mature-age applicants are welcome.

Starting Dates

Semester 1 commences in the 2nd week of February. Enrolments need to be completed by the end of January.

Mid-year enrolment is also an option for part-time study. Enrolments need to be completed by mid-June.

This course may be studied full-time over 2 years or part-time over 3 to 5 years.

Brougham School of Art & Photography's unique delivery of this course aims to:

The Diploma aims to equip graduates with the knowledge, skills and confidence to:

- ◆ Set up a professional artist studio
- ◆ Apply for positions in art related industries
- ◆ Complete further study at higher education institutions or progress into the Advanced Diploma of Fine Arts at Brougham School of Art & Photography

Fees

The initial enrolment fee is \$250.00 and must be paid 7 days after an offer of a place in the course is made to the applicant.

Payment is made per semester.

The diploma units are grouped under subject headings and most subjects are priced at \$500 per semester.

Therefore a part-time student who chooses to study 2 subjects at a time will be invoiced at \$1000 for the semester.

Depending on the length of time taken to complete the diploma, the total is approximately \$12,000.

Students also need make allowance for the supply of most of their own art materials.

Units and Delivery Structure

Units are grouped under 'subject' headings. 1st year students complete the compulsory units and elect 2 streams of study. In 2nd year students complete compulsory units and continue with the streams chosen in 1st year, undertaking 2 major studies.
